## Skipper/Owner Responsibilities

The skipper/owner must ensure that all safety equipment is properly maintained and stowed and that the yacht's crew knows where it is and how to use it.

I agree to waive my rights to take legal action against and release and forever discharge the Deep Bay Yacht Club and its respective organizers, agents, officials, servants and representatives (collectively the "organizers") from and against any and all claims, actions, costs or expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to my person or property howsoever caused, arising out of or connected with my participation in such races, notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to, caused or occasioned by the negligence of the organizers of any of them. I understand that this waiver and release is binding upon my heirs, my executors, assigns and myself".
